The Soroptimist International of Middletown Miami University Scholarship is up to a \$2,000 scholarship offered annually to one or more female students who have graduated within the past eight years from high school or GED program, is age 25 or under, and is enrolled as a full-time (12 hours or more freshman, sophomore, or junior) student at Miami University and will be taking classes at Miami University in the Fall 2026. This scholarship is awarded on the basis of academic performance (3.0 or higher grade point average), the potential for advancement, and financial need. Payment is made directly to Miami University and applied toward the student's tuition. Children of Soroptimist members are not eligible.

Applications should be submitted online. If you cannot submit your application online, print off an application, use black ink, print neatly, and mail the completed application to the address below.

Return this completed application with the following items.

- Two letters of reference
 - One should be from a non-family member
 - One must be from a Miami University professor, also not a family member.
- A current official Miami University transcript with the most recently completed semester posted (may have to be sent separately to the address below)
